- o I have quotations with accurate citations: book.line number in parenthesis
  - for example: "I wish my stomach would let me / cut off your flesh in strips and eat it raw." (*Iliad* 22.384-385)
- Each of my quotations clearly supports my thesis
- o All of my adverbs (words ending in –ly / "very") are absolutely necessary
- o I haven't unnecessarily summarized bits of the plot
- The titles of major works are in *italics*
- o I have typed the words "Enough of your candy antics" on the last page of my essay
- o I have not referred to page or line numbers within my prose
  - for example, do **not** say "In lines 220-224, Hector shows his love for his wife"
- o I have not said "I think" "I believe" "I feel" anywhere in my paper
- o None of my sentences begin "It is/It's," "There is/There's," or "There are"
- I have written in formal, polished prose, and have avoided colloquial (chatty, conversational) writing
