Computer automation puts almost 50% of US jobs at risk. Advances in machine learning make headlines around the globe, as computer programs beat us at chess and Go; diagnose rare diseases better than doctors; and drive cars more safely than we do. But whether these systems can or will ever *understand* what they do is not clear. Nor is it clear whether words have or can have *meaning* to them. The question remains open because we have not yet operationalized the *meaning of meaning*, which prevents us from putting these questions to an empirical test. This lecture will examine the question of artificial intelligence from the perspectives of both philosophy and mathematics.
