The following predental courses are mandatory and MUST be completed prior to admission to Dental School. There are no substitutes for these prerequisites:

A minimum of ninety (90) semester hours of course work must be completed by the time of matriculation. No more than sixty (60) semester hours may be completed at the junior college level. Applicants are encourage to complete upper-division level science courses at 4-year institutions (i.e., colleges or universities that grant bachelors degrees).

All prerequisites must have letter grades: no PASS/FAIL options are accepted. All science courses (except Biochemistry and Physiology) must include laboratories.

The following supplementary materials are required: (specific for IU Dental School)

<u>Application fee</u>: \$45.00 application fee (The fee for international applicants is \$55). Make check payable to Indiana University.

<u>Official transcripts</u> from all colleges/universities attended, if you did not submit them with your AADSAS application.

Official Dental Admission Test (DAT) scores.

Scores of 13 or higher are required in all sections of the DAT.

<u>Three academic letters of recommendation</u>, if you did not submit them with your AADSAS application.

At least two should be from your science professors; the third may be from any other professor. Interviews will be granted to selected applicants only after three (3) academic letters of recommendation have been received by the IU School of Dentistry.
