Instructions:

Re-read Cap. 6-11

Find a passage which is at least 100 words long and contains more than one character speaking.

Find that passage as read by me in my collection of recordings, available here:

<https://users.pfw.edu/flemingd/Recordings/Latin/LLpsi/>

Listen to my reading of that passage many times while reading along.

Practice imitating my pronunciation of the Latin.

Read it aloud in a way which shows you understand what the Latin is saying while you read it. Questions must sound like questions. Characters must have different voices, etc. Act it out.

When you are confident about your performance, make a recording of your own reading of the passage, and submit it to Brightspace.

Also submit a document which includes the page, chapter, and line numbers of your passage. ALSO copy and paste your passage onto the same document. You can access a pdf of the whole textbook here:

GRADING RUBRIC:

TEXT:

- Submitted reading (if no, grade = 0)
- is 100 words or longer (if no, grade = 0)
- Contains multiple speaking characters (if no, grade = 0)

AUDIO:

- Slow and clear (30/100)
- Classical pronunciation (esp. “c” “g” “v” and vowels) (30/100)
- Different voices for characters (30/100)
- Suggests time and effort has been taken with this (10/100)
