

Four **Principal Parts** of each verb:

### **First Conjugation ā**

[amō, amāre, amāvī, amātum]

amō, “I love” (first person, singular, present, indicative, active)

amāre, “to love” (present, active, infinitive)

amāvī, “I loved” (first person, singular, perfect, indicative, active)

amātum, “[having been] loved” (perfect passive participle = an adjective)

### **Second Conjugation ē**

[videō, vidēre, vīdī, vīsum]

videō, “I see”

vidēre, “to see”

vīdī, “I saw”

vīsum, “[having been] seen”

### **Third Conjugation e**

[ponō, ponere, posuī, positum]

ponō, “I put”

ponere, “to put”

posuī, “I put” [past tense “I have put”]

positum, “[having been] put”

### **Third Conjugation *i-stem* e**

[capiō, capere, cēpī, captum]

capiō, “I take”

capere, “to take”

cēpī, “I took”

captum, “[having been] taken”

### **Fourth Conjugation *ī***

[audiō, audīre, audīvī, audītum]

audiō, “I hear”

audīre, “to hear”

audīvī, “I heard”

audītum, “[having been] heard”
