<b>Quis?</b> (who?)	Mārcus <i>aut</i> Quīntus <i>aut</i> Iūlia <i>aut</i> Syra <i>aut</i> Medus [answer is Nominative person]
<b>Quae?</b> (who? <i>fem</i> )	Iūlia <i>aut</i> Aemelia <i>aut</i> Syra <i>aut</i> Delia [answer is Nominative feminine person]
<b>Quid?</b> (what?)	fluvius <i>aut</i> oppidum <i>aut</i> vocabulum <i>aut</i> pagina [answer is Nominative thing]
<b>Quī sunt?</b> (who? <i>masc.plural</i> )	filiī <i>aut</i> servī <i>aut</i> puerī <i>aut</i> virī [answer is Nominative masculine plural people]
<b>Quae sunt?</b> (who? <i>fem.plural</i> )	filiae <i>aut</i> feminae <i>aut</i> ancillae <i>aut</i> puellae [answer is Nominative feminine plural people]
<b>Cuius?</b> (whose?)	Mārcī <i>aut</i> Quīntī <i>aut</i> Iūliae <i>aut</i> Syrae <i>aut</i> Medī [answer is Genitive (possessive)]
<b>Ubi?</b> (where? In what place?)	hic! <i>aut</i> ibi! <i>aut</i> in Italiā <i>aut</i> in Africā <i>aut</i> in oppidō <i>aut</i> ante ōstium [mostly Ablative or Locative]
<b>Quō?</b> (to what place?)	Ad villam <i>aut</i> in villam <i>aut</i> Romam [mostly Accusative]
<b>Quot?</b> (how many?)	unus <i>aut</i> duo <i>aut</i> tres <i>aut</i> centum <i>aut</i> multī <i>aut</i> paucī [Numbers etc.]
<b>Cur?</b> (why?)	Quia...[Because...]

**Quālis?** (what kind?)

parva *aut* magna *aut* Romana

**Quantus?** (How much)

multī *aut* paucī

**... -ne?** (“does...?”)

Ita! *aut* Minime!

**Nōnne...?** (“doesn’t...?”)

Ita! [expects a “yes” answer]

**Num...?** (“doesn’t...?”)

Minime! *aut* Immo! [expects a “no” answer]

**Quid facit? / Quid agit** (what is she doing?)

dormit *aut* vocat *aut* plorat [answer is a Verb]

**Quem pulsat?** (whom is he hitting?)

Iūliam *aut* eam *aut* eum *aut* Quīntum pulsat [answer is in the Accusative]

**Cui dat?** (to whom does he give?)

Iuliae *aut* Quinto [answer is in the Dative]

**Quōmodo?** (how?)

bene! *aut* male *aut* hahahae!
