

## What is involved in participating JAUPLI?

Your students may participate as much or as little as you define.

Students who are submitting papers will also receive papers and calibration exercises to review. The calibration exercises will appear to be student written papers, but have documented issues.

All submission is done on-line.

Papers will be limited to approximately 1,000 words for both the writers and reviewers sakes. The expectation is that students write about the overall meaning of the data and carefully explain the investigation so that another student can understand it.

As every University/College has its own unique time schedule, submission dates will be October, December, March, and May. Individual instructors can participate in one or all of these times. The specific schedule can be changed with discussion.

Students in all post introductory laboratory experience are invited to participate.

Faculty members whose classes are participating will be expected to review some articles and perhaps provide a calibration article.

Faculty members whose classes are participating will need to enforce timely review of papers.

Early adopters get to help form the direction of the journal, input in formation of rubrics.

Participating faculty members also get valuable insight as to what investigations are occurring at other institutions.
